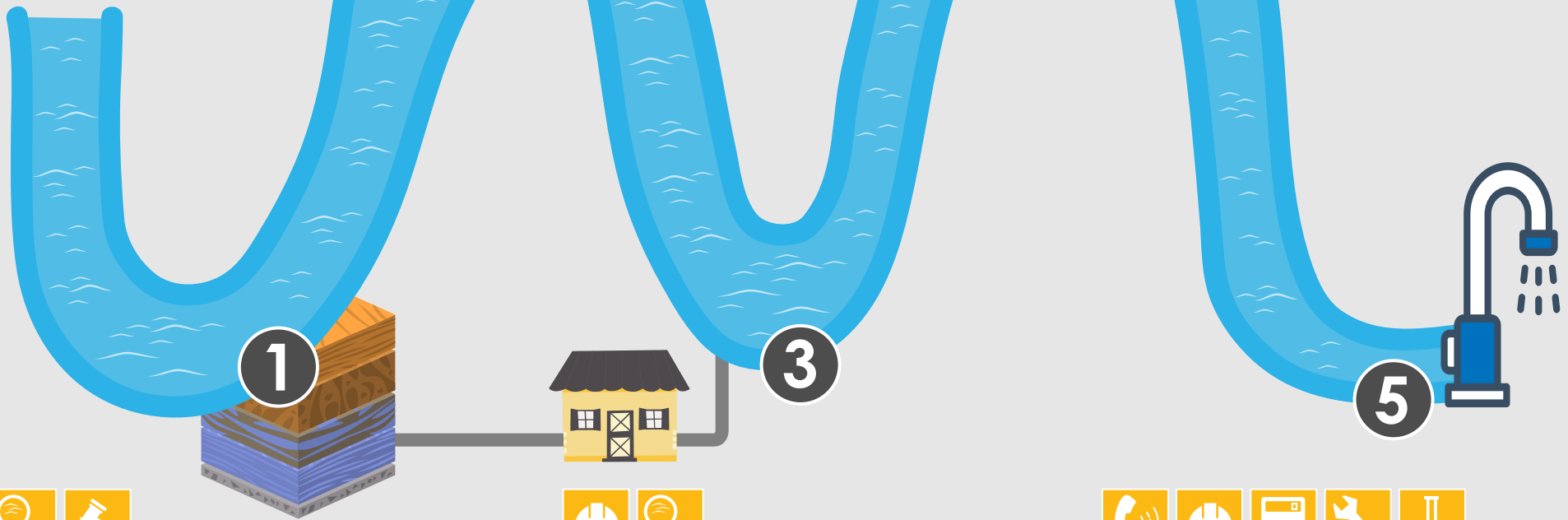

The "Ws" of Your Water



1 | Where

Getting water to you starts with determining where, and how much, water is available. ECCV works with **hydrogeologists** and **water attorneys** to evaluate current and potential water supplies both on the surface (rivers and streams) and underground (aquifers).



2 | Who

Most every drop of water in Colorado is legally claimed. So much so that water has its own, specialized court in Colorado. ECCV works with **water attorneys** to obtain rights to new water supplies and protect our customers' rights to existing supplies.



4 | When

Water demand and supply levels are constantly changing. ECCV's operations team, including **treatment plant operators, water quality, maintenance and field technicians** work each day to adjust the system as necessary to ensure delivery of high quality water to your home.



3 | What

The majority of your water comes from the South Platte River. Much of the rest comes from deep underground. ECCV employs engineers, and works with **engineering** and **hydrogeologist** partners to construct and maintain a system capable of delivering safe, reliable water.



5 | Why

Water is essential to our daily lives. We use it for drinking, cooking, cleaning, and sanitation. Sustaining our community by providing safe, reliable water is a team effort. **Operations, engineering, customer and business services,** and a team of partners go into each drop.
