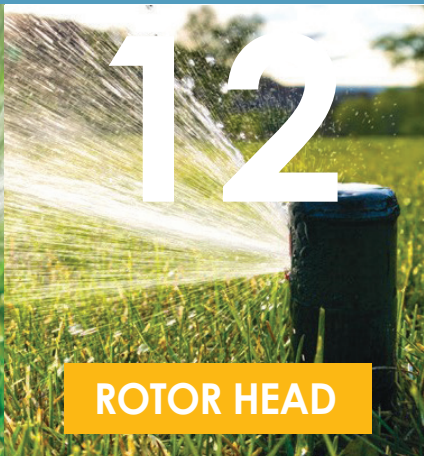

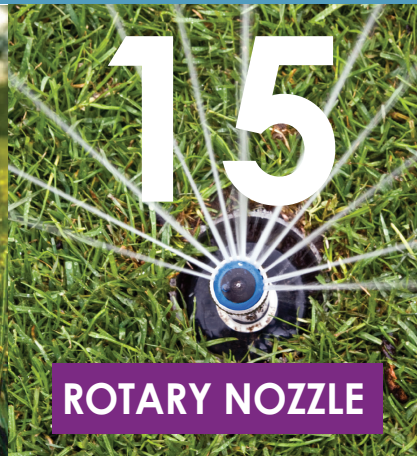
Recommended Minutes PER CYCLE by Sprinkler Type

Midseason System Check

We are heading into the height of summer when heat and dry weather means yards need a little more water. In addition to adjusting run times for sprinkler systems (see above), this is also a good time to check on a few components of your sprinkler system to make sure things are working as they should.

When the system is running, take a look at your sprinkler heads. Look for any gaps in the spray pattern for fixed or rotary head nozzles. Also look for any heads that are tilted as this can leave portions of your yard outside the spray area, preventing them from getting water. On that note, look for any areas where water is landing on paved areas, and adjust the aim of heads as necessary.

Remember, ECCV offers rebates for new sprinkler bodies and nozzles. If something isn't working, or needs to be replaced, we can help cover the cost. Fixing sprinklers that are leaking or broken can also reduce water bills and keeps yards healthier.

Meter Domes

The casing and cover that protect your home's water meter is called the meter dome. The covers of these domes can wear down over time and give way if stepped on. When checking in on sprinklers, take a quick look at your meter dome (if located outdoors). If it's sturdy and in good shape, you're all set. If it appears brittle or damaged, give ECCV a call at 303-693-3800 and our team will schedule a time to come replace it at no charge.
