

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE

Water Use Restrictions For Customers of the East Cherry Creek Valley Water & Sanitation District

The East Cherry Creek Valley Water & Sanitation District (the “District”) declares the following water restrictions (the “Water Restrictions”):

Water Restrictions **BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026**

- **Prohibition of all outdoor turf watering.**
- **Grass establishment is prohibited, except pursuant to a District-approved variance solely for residential properties actively participating in Resource Central’s Lawn Replacement program.**
- **Trees, shrubs, and perennials may not be watered by spray irrigation. However, they may be watered on any day using either:**
 - **A hand-held hose equipped with a shut-off nozzle, for up to one hour at a time while continuously attended, or**
 - **A drip irrigation system following the schedule outlined below.**
- **Annuals and vegetables may not be watered by spray irrigation. However, they may be watered on any day using either:**
 - **A hand-held hose equipped with a shut-off nozzle, for up to one hour at a time while continuously attended, or**
 - **A drip irrigation system following the scheduled outline below.**
- **Drip irrigation is limited to one day per week on the specified day. Residential customers with even numbered addresses may only use drip irrigation on Sundays. Residential customers with odd numbered addresses may only use drip irrigation on Saturdays. Drip irrigation shall only be used between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.**

Penalties for violating the Water Restrictions under Section 12.3 of the Rules & Regulations are as follows:

Waste of Water Violation Fee

Offense Number	Per Meter on Account
1	Warning
2	\$100
3	\$250
4	\$500
5	\$1000
6	Shut Off

The District may, in its sole discretion, choose to shut off service in advance of the 6th violation in accordance with the Rules & Regulations.

The Water Restrictions shall be in place until terminated by the District Manager or the Board of Directors. Any termination of the Water Restrictions will be posted on the District's website and will be effective upon the posting thereof.

This Notice of Water Restrictions constitutes evidence of the District's water restrictions currently in place and may be used by District customers to evidence the same for purposes of Section 38-33.3-302(1)(k)(II), C.R.S. for as long as it is posted on the District's website.

Effective Date:

Pursuant to Article 12.4.4 of the Rules & Regulations, the above Water Restrictions shall go into effect **OCTOBER 1, 2026** and shall be posted on the District's website: <https://www.eccv.org/public-notices>.
